### Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Chirne del Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered. Rare and foundation breeds are eligible. All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with the AKC, ~~AKC~~ or an AKC recognized foreign registry or AKC board approved registry.

### Stakes Offered

**OPEN STAKE** Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements including ASFA certifications, ASFA Field Champions, CKC Field Champions

**SPECIALS STAKE** Any AKC field Champion

**VETERAN STAKE** Any eligible sighthound 6 years of age or older (5 years for IW or 7 years for Whippets) that has met certification requirements.

**RARE STAKE** Any sighthound of all eligible breeds that has met certification requirements.

**SINGLES STAKE** Any eligible sighthound. Hounds will be run alone. Dogs with breed disqualifications are allowed to run.

**JC/QC TEST** These tests are open to hounds at least 12 months of age. The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four turns.

**Consult AKC rule book for additional information – will be available on field.**

**There will be a Best in Field each day.**

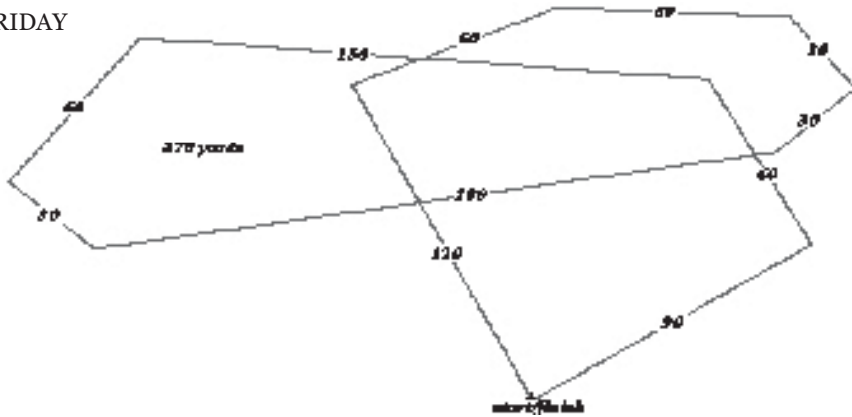
### Conditions of Entry

- ❖ All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- ❖ Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period entry fees will not be refunded.
- ❖ Stakes may be split if sufficient entries are present in any one state at the time of the draw to support more than one 5-point Major.
- ❖ Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entries will be refunded.
- ❖ Hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.
- ❖ A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose hound on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- ❖ Battery powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic.
- ❖ Back-up equipment will be available.
- ❖ BGCC reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the trial.
- ❖ Course will be reversed for finals, run-offs, and BOB.
- ❖ The field is not dog fenced, but it is well away from the road.
- ❖ Bring your own shade and water.
- ❖ There is a running stream and a pond available for use near the field.

### CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

All hounds must be certified prior to competing in an AKC trial, except for the Singles Stakes. If this is the first trial for your hound your certification form **MUST** accompany your entry.

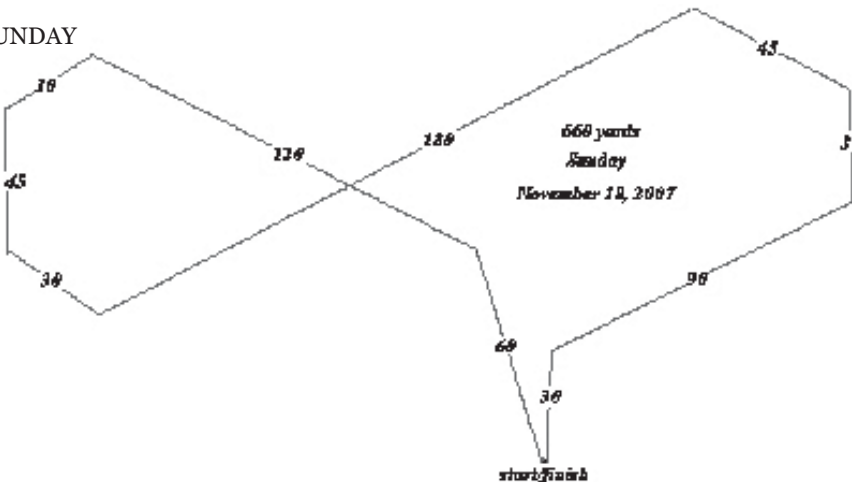

### COURSE PLANS

All trials will be continuous loop. A battery powered lure machine will be used. Backup equipment will be available. Lure will be highly visible plastic strips. The field is not fenced for dogs, but is well away from the road with cattle fencing. Bring your own shade and water. There is a stream near the field. Courses will be reversed for finals, and again for runoffs and BOB. BGCC reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field conditions.

### WELCOME TO THE CURRY FARM

Be aware we have horses and cows that love to eat trash, especially cigarette butts, **please** pick after yourself. We have provided trash cans and a dumpster.

We do not mind dogs free running, **except** during trial hours. There are some barbed wire fences and some electric fences. There is a pond, and a creek; feel free to jump in (swimsuits optional) or let your dog go in (no lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk).

Should the weather be bad, please contact ahead of time about type of vehicle you are driving for parking instructions. Please stop at the house before driving onto field.

There should be time for practices and certifications each day.

### DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

**From I-75 North** take Exit #41, turn onto Hwy. 80 West to Somerset, Ky., approx. 38 miles. In Somerset, cross Hwy. 27 and follow signs to the Cumberland Pkwy. west toward Bowling Green, Ky. Stay on Cumberland Pkwy. to Exit #49. Turn left onto Hwy. 55 South, go 1/2 mile to Hwy. 704 – Hwy. 704 forks right. Stay on Hwy. 704 approximately 2 1/2-3 miles to North Johnson School Rd. Turn right, go one mile until blacktop makes a 90-degree turn to the left (Don't go left, go straight onto gravel.). Stay straight onto Elbert Frankum Rd. Farm is on the left. Go down the gravel, follow signs for parking.

**From I-75 South** take Exit #62 turn right onto Hwy. 461, and go to Hwy. 80 (16 miles). Turn right onto Hwy. 80 and follow above directions.

**From I-65 North or South** take Exit #43, Cumberland Pkwy., east to exit #49, Columbia, turn right onto Hwy. 55 South then same as above.
